Rob (insert)

Great! I leave you to it now.

(door opens again)

Finn (insert)

Hi Neil! I must tell you my presentation was a success. Your advice made all the difference!

Vera (insert)

Hi Neil! You were so good at...

What can I do, I am a people person! In English, you say someone is a 'people person' when they are good at dealing with people. They are helpful, extroverts, approachable. People like me, Feifei.

Feifei

(mellowing) 这么说如果一个人善于与别人打交道，你就可以称之为“a people person 有人缘的人”。A people person 往往开朗乐观，乐于助人，有亲和力。你的确算是个 people person，我很喜欢和你搭档做节目 Neil。

Neil

Let's hear some examples of how this expression is used.

Examples

Callum is a people person. He gets along with everybody and would make a great manager.

You should go to the party even if you don't know anybody there. You are a people person and by the end of the night you'll have made many new friends.

(sound of crowd outside)

Feifei

(a bit suspicious) 录音师外面怎么围了一大堆人？ So many people outside the studio... Neil, who are they?

Neil

Oh, these are colleagues and friends I've helped out a bit recently.

Feifei

But this is... it's a crowd!

Neil

(confident and a bit full of himself) I told you: I'm a people person! (loud) Hello everyone! I'll be there in a minute!
